The Postal Unique Supply and Equipment contract number 1CDSEQ-04-P-7537 was competitively awarded to Postal Products Unlimited on October 1st, 2004 for all Postal employees when purchasing Postal Unique supplies and equipment. This strategic partnership has been implemented nationally and all purchases of Postal Unique supplies and equipment should be made from Postal Products Unlimited. The Postal Service has renewal options with this contract until 2014.

This Postal Unique Supplies and Equipment eBuy Reference Catalog contains a wide range of supplies and equipment uniquely designed and intended for mailing and Postal applications and operations. The Postal Service receives discounts on all contract items, including all items featured in this catalog. The USPS also receives an annual rebate for all purchases made on eBuy. Current pricing for all Postal Products Unlimited items is available on the USPS intranet site and from the Postal Products Unlimited Customer Service Department at 1-800-229-4500.

Ordering and Payment: A Postal employee needs a valid FEDSTRIP to place a Postal Unique supply & equipment order. The FEDSTRIP order should be placed via the USPS eBuy intranet system. For offices without intranet access, ordering via phone at 1-800-229-4500 or fax at 1-800-570-0007 are also acceptable options. All eBuy purchases are to be paid using FEDSTRIP and will be electronically invoiced by Postal Products Unlimited to the USPS San Mateo Processing Center.

When ordering a product that is not in the Postal Products Unlimited eBuy catalog, call the Customer Service Department at 1-800-229-4500 for a price quotation. Postal Products Unlimited has already created an account for each office for credit card and Net 30 day billings and will be pleased to invoice the Post Office for non-eBuy purchases.

For your convenience, Postal Products Unlimited has no minimum ordering requirements. Items that are in stock will ship in 24 hours. Postage is pre-paid and the actual postage is added to the FEDSTRIP. All orders placed on the eBuy site will ship Parcel Post (Standard Mail) unless otherwise specified. Customers seeking expedited shipping should specify Priority or Express mail when ordering on-line or they must call our Customer Service Department at 1-800-229-4500 and request the change. Thus, the ordering Post Office is paying the United States Postal Service for delivery of their products, rather than having the shipping charges factored into the price of the product and using a non-Postal method of delivery. Products that exceed USPS weight or dimensional requirements for shipping through the mail stream will ship via Postal Service Bill of Lading (formerly known as Government Bill of Lading) issued by Postal Products Unlimited.

Postal Products Unlimited, Inc. no longer requires offices to prepare Government Bills of Lading. Postal Products has been authorized to use the U.S. Postal Service's Web-based Freight Traffic Management Lading for items too large for mail; do not use them for mailable items.
